

Accommodation

Venue

Cowes 3922. There is no parking at the front of the centre in Lyons Court, just a quick drop off, but parking in available in nearby streets. 


Meals

Directions

Phillip Island is about 2 hours from Melbourne. Allow extra time for the drive to Cowes. The Phillip Island Visitors Centre is signposted on the left a short distance after crossing the bridge. It is well worth calling in.



Program

All activities will be for a half day. Each will be designated as to the challenge level involved. Participants will sign up for activities on registration and will be given times and directions as to where to meet. Convoying will also be encouraged. More later.
